

Grants - Common Application

Grant Overview: Racine Lutheran High School offers several grant opportunities to support families and students participating in tuition payment plan and that demonstrate a commitment to Christian education, academic excellence, and community involvement. Below, you will find details about three distinct grants available for prospective students: the Association Grant, the Christian Education Commitment Grant, and the Merit Grant.

Applications are encouraged to be submitted by March 1 but will be accepted on a rolling basis. Ensure all necessary documents, attachments, and signatures are included.

1. Association Grant

What Is It?

The Association Grant is available to students who are members of one of the school's Association Congregations.

Eligibility Criteria

- The student and at least one parent must be active members of an Association Congregation.
- Requires the signature of the pastor.

2. Christian Education Commitment Grant

What Is It? The Christian Education Grant provides financial assistance to students from families committed to Christian education. The grant is applied directly to tuition.

Who Is Eligible?

- Families with an 8th grade student attending a Non-Association Lutheran or other Christian school.
- Families of Association congregations already receive the Association member's grant and are not eligible for this program.

Grant Amount

- Awards are based on consecutive years of enrollment in a Lutheran or Christian school through 8th grade.
- The maximum grant is \$500 for five consecutive years or more. The amount decreases by \$100 for each year less than five. For example:
 - Enrolled since 4th grade: \$500.
 - Enrolled since 5th grade: \$400.

Renewal Criteria

- The student must remain enrolled in good standing academically.
- Maintain a good discipline record.
- The family must be timely in paying tuition.

3. Merit Grant

What Is It? The Merit Grant is awarded to incoming students who have demonstrated outstanding academic abilities.

Eligibility Criteria

- Maintain a GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- Grants are limited and awarded competitively.
- Grants are applied toward tuition and automatically renewed if criteria are met.
